LICENCES ACT, 2010

*(Act 23 of 2010)***Licences (Petroleum Storage and Sale) (Amendment) Regulations, 2011**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 28 of the Licences Act, 2010, the Vice-President and Minister of Finance and Trade makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Licences (Petroleum Storage and Sale) (Amendment) Regulations, 2011.

Citation

2. The Licences (Petroleum Storage and Sale) Regulations are amended as follows —

- (a) in Regulation 3(b), by repealing the words “Fire Brigade” and substituting therefor the words “Fire Services Agency”;
- (b) in Regulation 5(c), by repealing the words “Fire Brigade” and substituting therefor the words “Fire Services Agency”;
- (c) in Regulation 7(2) (b) , by repealing the words “Fire Brigade” and substituting therefor the words “Fire Services Agency”;
- (d) by repealing subregulation 9(1) and substituting therefor —

“(1) A licence granted under these Regulations shall be valid for a period of 5 years unless revoked by the Authority”.

- (e) in the Schedule, by repealing paragraph (a) and renumbering paragraph (b) as paragraph (a).
